Direct Composites: Minimally Traumatic Preparations and Restorative Protocols Workshop



Instructor Qualifications

Dr. David Clark founded the Academy of Microscope Enhanced Dentistry, an international association formed to

advance the science and practice of microendodontics, microperiodontics, microprosthodontics and microdentistry. He is a course director at the Newport Coast Oral Facial Institute in Newport Beach, California. He is co-director of Precision Aesthetics Northwest in Tacoma Washington, and an associate member of the American Association of Endodontists. He lectures and gives hands-on seminars internationally on a variety of topics related to microscope-enhanced dentistry. He has developed numerous innovations in the fields of micro dental instrumentation, imaging, and dental operatory design. Dr. Clark has authored several landmark articles about microscope dentistry including Aesthetic Dentistry, Sealants, The Role of Ultrasonics in Three Dimensional Shaping and Restoration of Non Vital Teeth, Micro-Imaging and Practice Management, and Crack Diagnosis.

DESCRIPTION OF COURSE CONTENT

Participants will prepare, fill, and polish minimally traumatic Class I and II restorations. The Clark Class II composites restoration will be taught, utilizing the Bioclear™ matrix systems and flowable and paste composites. Minimally invasive diastema closure and papilla regeneration will be explained and performed. Various matrixing systems and separators will be demonstrated and utilized to create ideal contacts and embrasure shapes. Simplified polishing for a mirror smooth surface will be demonstrated. Participants will take home complimentary bur kits that include Fissurotomy™ burs, matrix systems, and composite polishers. Microscopes available for some attendees.

DESCRIPTION OF COURSE CONTENT

Cone Beam CT (CBCT) technology is a relatively new addition to the dental practice that has taken off with exponential growth. CBCT systems are designed to allow for high resolution imaging of the hard tissues of the maxillofacial region. CBCT allows for short scanning times and radiation doses, significantly less than traditional scanning techniques. The availability of this technology in the dental practice provides the dental practitioner with an imaging modality capable of providing 3-D orthogonal representation of maxillofacial region with no distortion. With the explosive growth of third party Dicom software applications, we are able to improve treatment for our patients with greater predictability and efficiency. This workshop will review Kodak 3D Software, with a focus on hands-on 3D Case Study/Volume(s) interpretation and manipulation.

2-3 multi-rooted teeth not mounted with straight line access cavities prepared, teeth must be patent to a #8 or #10 file; DG16 or other Endo explorer; gloves; mask; loupes.

DESCRIPTION OF COURSE CONTENT

This multi media course is designed for the general practitioner to improve their daily Endodontic skills. Areas covered will include diagnosis, case selection, the latest Endodontic instrumentation and the cleansing and shaping and packing of the root canal system in three dimensions with warm obturation techniques and bonded obturation. The course will also include an introduction to the surgical operating microscope as well as discuss the importance of coronal seal and the role of Endodontics in treatment planning.

- Review irrigation, instrumentation and obturation theory in light of achieving the biologic objectives of root canal therapy
- Provide an interactive learning experience that allows the participant to confidently take the advocated rotary methods and warm obturation techniques back into the office the next working day
